## Pembrokeshire Alpaca Trekking

## Waiver Agreement

By signing this waiver agreement, the client agrees to the following terms:

- You must be 14 + to walk your own Alpaca.
- If you are between 5-14 years of age, then you must share an Alpaca with a responsible adult.
- Strictly no children under the age of 5 on the trekking
- A maximum of 2 people per Alpaca.
- In extreme wet and windy weather, we reserve the right to cancel the trek if it is unsafe. If this is the case a full refund will be given or the option to rearrange. We also have the right to stop or cancel during the trek should any person pose a risk a risk to themselves or the welfare of the alpaca or other walkers.
- If you are late for your booked slot you will miss the trek and not be granted a refund.
- You are required to attend the full safety briefing prior to the trek.

I am agreeing that I am responsible for the behaviour of myself and children, any unreasonable behaviour will not be tolerated, and you will be asked to leave. I have taken medical advice on any pre-existing conditions and can confirm it is medically safe for me to participate in the trek. If I become unwell at any time, I will inform the trek leader straight away.

I acknowledge that there are risks involved and I am walking on uneven occasionally slippery ground.

I fully realise the dangers of participating and although the animals are fully halter trained, they may rarely be frightened which may cause unpredictable behaviour. Therefore, I assume the risk associated with my participation and my well-being and safety during the treks.

I understand and agree to the that situations may arise during the trek, which may be beyond the immediate control of the trek organisers. I agree that to the extent permissible by law, the trek organisers have no liability to me whatsoever for any direct or indirect loss, (including, but not limited to injury or death) sustained by me during or in any way related to my participation in the trek.
